

2018 OXFORD PARKING INFORMATION

Pay and Display Parking – Streets in the vicinity of College

There are a good number of parking bays with Pay and Display machines in the streets around College and charges, revised in February 2018, are set out below. After 10pm there is no charge and no ticket required		

Notes for evening parking: 1, 2 or 3 hour tickets purchased with the expiry time of 6.31pm or after are valid for the evening period. Please note this does not apply to 30 minute tickets.

On Street Parking – North Oxford

Parking in the residential streets north of College and north of Park Town (on the Banbury Road) is **Residents' Parking Permits only**.

There are 5 Park and Ride schemes around Oxford, at the four compass points, with two to the north. These are well sign posted from the main approach roads to Oxford:

Buses run frequently (every 10 -15 minutes) to and from the centre of Oxford up until approx. 7.15pm and then approx. every 30 minutes. The last bus to each of the Park & Rides leaves the centre of Oxford between 11pm and 11.50 pm. Parking for Disabled

Unlimited Parking is permissible free of charge in Pay and Display and in Residents' Parking bays of which there are many in Museum, Blackhall and Keble Roads, if Disabled Badge is clearly displayed.

It is permissible to park on double yellow lines (not Loading areas) for a maximum of 3 hours provided it is safe (Keble, Blackhall or Museum Roads, but not Parks Road) and the Disabled Badge is clearly displayed.
