Alice Notley is the author of more than 40 books of poetry. She has been a finalist for the Pulitzer Prize, and winner of the Griffin International Poetry Prize and the Los Angeles Times Book Award for Poetry. In the spring of 2001 she received an Academy Award from the American Academy of Arts and Letters and the Poetry Society of America's Shelley Memorial Award. She edited and wrote a new introduction to her late husband Ted Berrigan's *The Sonnets* (Penguin, 2000), as well as editing, with her sons, *The Collected Poems of Ted Berrigan* (2007). Last year she published *Runes and Chords*, *The Speak Angel Series* and *Early Works*, and *Telling the Truth as It Comes Up: Selected Talks & Essays 1991-2018*.
