

2025 Admissions Round Feedback

Biomedical Sciences

Please note this is subject admissions feedback from the 2025 selection round – there will be changes each year, and these pages are only retained to provide a general indication of process.

The team at Keble interviewed 18 candidates for BC98 biomedical sciences, blind to college choice, with 12 candidates putting Keble as their first-choice college. All candidates had two interviews at Keble, with both panels comprising one systems (Prof. Butt/Dr. Camm) and one cellular/molecular (Prof. Gruneberg/Dr. Kyriakou) biology interviewer. All four interviewers submitted independent scores for each candidate on a scale of 1 to 5, with the sum total of these scores used for initial ranking of the candidates. The average total score was 14.6 with a range of 8.0 to 18.25. Following submission of our initial ranking, the central admissions team released second college interview ranking as well as BMSAT scores for the candidates interviewed by us. The average BSMAT score for candidates interviewed by Keble was 72.2, with a range of 57.5 to 87.5. Keble made 3 conditional offers to start October 2025 with these candidates having an average interview score of 17.25 and BMSAT score of 63.75. A further candidate was made a conditional offer by another college.
