

Poets at Keble presents a reading by
Keston Sutherland



Keston Sutherland is described by the *New Statesman* as being ‘at the forefront of the experimental movement in contemporary British poetry’. He is Professor of Poetics at the University of Sussex, where he has taught for over twenty years, and has held visiting posts as the Holloway Poetry Fellow at UC Berkeley and the Bain-Swiggett Professor of Poetry at Princeton. With Andrea Brady, he has coedited Barque Press since 1995. He is particularly known for his performances: a reading of *Hot White Andy* (2007) (which John Wilkinson called ‘the most remarkable poem in English published this century’) has received over 18,000 views on YouTube. His most recent publications, *Meditations* (2024) and *Jokes* (2025), are available from The Last Books, and his *Poetical Works 1999–2015* was published by Enithamon.
