

2025 Admissions Round Feedback

Medicine

Please note this is subject admissions feedback from the 2025 selection round – there will be changes each year, and these pages are only retained to provide a general indication of process.

The team at Keble interviewed 33 candidates for A100 medicine, blind to college choice, with 19 candidates putting Keble as their first-choice college. All candidates had two interviews with one interview largely testing academic ability (Profs. Butt & Gruneberg), and the other focused more on aptitude for medicine (Drs. Christodoulides & Spence). All four interviewers submitted independent scores for each candidate on a scale of 0 to 4, with the sum total of these scores used for initial ranking of the candidates. The average total score was 12.1 with a range of 8.75 to 15.0. Following submission of our initial ranking, the central admissions team released second college interview ranking as well as UCAT scores for the candidates interviewed by us. The average UCAT score for candidates interviewed by Keble was 2418, with a range of 1900 to 2670. 14 of the candidates interviewed at Keble were made conditional offers to read medicine at the University of Oxford, starting in October 2026, with a further candidate taken as a deferred entry by another college. Of these, 6 conditional offers were made by Keble to candidates with an average interview score of 13.7 and UCAT score of 2462. A further open offer was underwritten by the college.
